About Community Nights Out

Habitat for Humanity of Montgomery County, Maryland is partnering with local restaurants in an effort to build our local community together. As a participant you would agree to partner with Habitat to host a Community Night Out at your restaurant, donating a percentage of your proceeds during a day or specific time frame to our organization. For example, one participating restaurant donates 20% of their proceeds from 4-9pm on the last Monday of each month.

What is Habitat for Humanity?

Habitat for Humanity of Montgomery County is an affiliate of Habitat for Humanity International. We are primarily a volunteer run organization, working with individuals, institutions, businesses and the Habitat partner families to build simple, decent, affordable housing for those living in substandard conditions in our community. Habitat is not a give away program, it is about partnering with local families who purchase their home and provide hundreds of hours of labor (sweat equity) to help build their home and the homes of others.

Our goal is to make the dream of homeownership possible for low-income families in our community.
